



EDUCATION

The education industry consists of public and private education institutions that range from pre-school to higher education.



Special Education Teachers teach academic, social and life skills to middle school students with learning, emotional or physical disabilities. This includes teachers who specialize and work with students with visual and hearing impairments.

Orientation and Mobility Instructors are tasked with teaching the visually impaired to travel confidently and safely in their respective environments. They work in schools, communities, hospitals and homes to ensure that the visually impaired are equipped to navigate independently. Workers have the minimal educational attainment of a Bachelor's degree, typically in education/special education programs.

A STEM education integrates the disciplines of science, technology, engineering and mathematics through an applied approach. STEM teachers plan and teach this curriculum to students in elementary or secondary school. This includes teachers in physics, chemistry, biology, computer, engineering, mathematics and other sciences.
